

Directions



Arriving by Car

Austria has an excellent highway and road network.

From East:

The Smart Apart Living can be reached via the A23 by taking the Gürtel / Landstraße exit towards Landstraße Hauptstraße / B221 / Gürtel. After 1.5 km turn left onto Ghegastraße. Follow the road for 1.5km, then turn left into Sonnwendgasse. After 450m turn left onto Gudrunstraße. After 100m turn right on Waldgasse - after 200m the destination is on the right hand side.

From South:

A2 to the exit "Inzersdorf". Stay on the Triesterstraße for 3.5 km, then turn right on Gudrunstraße. Follow this road for 1.5km and then turn right into Waldgasse, after 200m you will find the destination on your right hand side

From West:

On the A1 take the B1 to Hütteldorf and follow for 9 km. Then turn right onto Gaudenzdorfer Gürtel / B221 and follow for 1.2km. Then keep left and continue on Margaretengürtel / B221 for 1km. At the Matzleinsdorferplatz turn right at Landgutgasse and stay for 1.2 km, then turn right at Sonnwendgasse. Follow this road for 450m, then turn left onto Gudrunstraße. After 100m turn right onto Waldgasse, after 200m the destination is on the right hand side.

Parking:

Parking facilities are available at underground garage Reumannplatz .(<http://bestinparking.at/garage/wien/rotenhofgasse/2a>) (Rotenhofgasse 2a, 1100 Vienna). GPS-coordinates, prices and further information can be found on their homepage.

Special traffic regulations in Austria:

- All motorways in Austria are subject to a toll! A vignette must be purchased before the start of the car journey and visibly attached to the car's window. The vignette can be obtained at all border crossings, tobacco shops and at car club like ARBÖ or ÖAMTC. (www.asfinag.at/maut/vignette)
- Citizens from other countries should have an international driving license.
- Each passenger car must have a reflective warning vest. If the driver leaves the car in emergency situations, he must wear the warning vest

Arriving by plane

Transfer by public transport from Vienna International Airport Schwechat:

The Smart Apart Living is a 25-minute drive from Vienna Schwechat Airport. Take the Railjet or IC directly to the central station of Vienna. From there it takes you only 2 subway stations (U1 to Reumannplatz). Taxi:

The airport is directly connected to the motorway A4. A taxi takes you to Smart Apart Living in 25 minutes.

Arriving by train

Take the train to the main train station (former South Railway Station). There you will find the connection to the U1 underground line. Take the U1 line to the subway station Reumannplatz. From there it is only a few minutes walk to the Smart Apart Living.
